 - In Virginia, the ratio of free colonists to slaves is nearly 1:1.

 In South Carolina it is approximately 1:2.
 Georgia took action against slave importation.
 First abolition society founded in Philadelphia
 April, first battles of the Revolutionary war waged between the British and Colonial armies at Lexington and Concord, Massachusetts.
 Black Minutemen participated in the fighting.

- July, George Washington announced ban on the enlistment of free blacks and slaves in the colonial army.
 - By the end of the year, he reverses the ban, ordering the Continental Army to accept the
- service of free blacks.November, Virginia Governor John Murray, Lord Dunmore, issued a proclamation announcing that any slave fighting on the side of the British would be liberated.
